Declaration will only be produced for animals that are either from a BVD free accredited herd or have been individually tested for the presence of BVD antigen (or virus) and found to be negative. Animals for which Declarations are required should be blood tested between 6 and 12 weeks before the sale; this applies for BVD antibody, L Hardjo antibody and IBR antibody.
