AMENDMENT TO DECISION 2011/163/EU ON THE APPROVAL OF RESIDUE MONITORING PLANS

5. Singapore approved for consignments of fresh meat of New Zealand origin
6. French Polynesia no longer approved for honey
7. Namibia no longer approved for wild game
