AMENDMENT TO REGULATION 2016/759 DEALING WITH THE IMPORT OF PRODUCTS OF ANIMAL ORIGIN

This letter is addressed to Border Inspection Posts and Chief Port Health Officers in England only.

Further to my letter of 24th June (OVS/2016/017), I am writing to advise that the Commission published Regulation 2016/1793 on 11th October, which applies from October 14th. The Regulation can be found at the following link:

The amending Regulation adds Taiwan to the list of countries from which it is permitted to import to the EU gelatine and collagen derived as well as treated raw materials from poultry including ratites and feathered game.
