### QUARTERLY UPDATES TO GB MODEL EXPORT HEALTH CERTIFICATES (EHCs) FOR ANIMALS AND ANIMAL PRODUCTS.

#### Purpose

- 1. Information regarding quarterly updates to GB model health certificates (See Annex).
- 2. To advise of an extension to the implementation period for the move to the streamlined certificates for the USA of three months.
- 3. To advise of an extension to the use of four non-streamlined certificates for the EU

#### Background

- 4. The quarterly updates to GB model health certificates were published today.
- 5. Trading partners must use these new versions from 31 October 2024, though some may choose to use them as soon as they are available on GOV.UK.
- To keep the frequency and number of changes to a minimum, not all proposed changes result in immediate amendments to certificates. Please see <u>Importer</u> <u>information note GEN 4</u> for a full list of clarifications. This document is updated regularly.
- 7. The United States of America has been granted a three-month extension to the implementation period for the move to streamlined certificates. They will still need to use the old certificates and will still be subject to BTOM checks where appropriate.

- 8. Until further notice, EU and EFTA countries may use the following certificates:
  - a. GBHC012E BOV-X v.4.1 (or GBHC620 BOV-X v.2.0)
  - b. GBHC013E BOV-Y v.3.0 (or GBHC621 BOV-Y v.2.0)
  - c. GBHC015E OVI-X v.4.1
  - d. GBHC016E OVI-Y v.3.0
