PERSONAL IMPORT RESTRICTIONS ON CERTAIN SHEEP AND GOAT COMMODITIES FROM THE EU, SWITZERLAND, NORWAY, ICELAND, LIECHTENSTEIN, THE FAROE ISLANDS AND GREENLAND DUE TO OUTBREAKS OF PESTE DES PETITS RUMINANTS (PPR)

### **Purpose**

 To inform you of tightened restrictions, from 1 February 2025, on personal imports of certain ovine and caprine commodities from the EU single market area, following a recent outbreak of Peste des Petits Ruminants (PPR) in Hungary.

# Background

- 2. Hungary reported their first case of PPR to WOAH on 27 January 2025: <u>WAHIS</u>. This outbreak was confirmed on 24 January 2025 in a sheep establishment with 1,810 sheep, located in Szentgyörgyvölgy, near the Hungarian-Slovenian border.
- Personal imports from the EU single market area of certain ovine and caprine commodities have already been restricted via TARP safeguard declarations (see OVS notes <u>2024/32</u>, <u>2024/33</u>, <u>2024/34</u>, <u>2024/60</u>).
- 4. These declarations, which previously suspended personal imports of all ovine and caprine milk and milk products (including those commercially produced and packaged) from Bulgaria, Greece and Romania as PPR-affected countries, have now been updated to suspend personal imports of the same products from Hungary.
- 5. The following safeguard declarations give effect to these restrictions:
  - a. <u>Peste des petits ruminants in the European Union: amendment to declaration of special measures (England)</u>

- b. <u>Peste des petits ruminants in the European Union: amendment to declaration of special measures (Wales)</u>
- c. <u>Peste des petits ruminants in European Union: declaration of special measures (Scotland)</u>
- 6. These safeguard measures apply from <u>1 February 2025</u> and will continue to apply until they are revoked or amended.
