CHANGE IN THE BORDER TARGET OPERATING MODEL (BTOM) RISK CATEGORY

Purpose

1. To inform you about changes in risk category for the following commodities from **24**th **February 2025**:

BOTH EU AND NON-EU IMPORTS:

Commodity	BTOM risk category	Inspection rate	Comments
Dry untreated wool or hair from animals other than those of porcine	Medium	1%	Further guidance and import conditions are set out in ABP/23A.

Importers should continue to use import documentation as set out in <u>Import of untreated wool and hair - Import Information Note</u> (IIN) ABP/23A - GOV.UK

Background

- 2. Previously, imports of all untreated wool and hair from the EU were considered low risk.
 - Animal by-products (products not intended for human consumption):
 risk categories for imports from EU to GB GOV.UK
- 3. Previously, imports of untreated wool and hair from non-EU countries were considered low or medium risk.
 - BTOM risk categories and inspection rates for animal and animal product imports from non-EU countries to Great Britain: summary tables - GOV.UK



4. The risk category of all imports of untreated wool and hair from animals other than those of the porcine species, from EU and non-EU countries will change to medium from 24th February 2025. The risk categories for imports on GOV.UK will be updated shortly to reflect this change.
