

## **APHA Briefing Note 36/22**

# Update to notes for guidance accompanying Animal Health Certificate (8233NFG)

Date issued: 29 September 2022

#### **Purpose**

To inform OVs about the latest updates to 8233NFG accompanying the Animal Health Certificate for non-commercial movements of dogs, cats and ferrets to the EU.

### **Background**

Following feedback from OVs, APHA updated the NFG to provide clarity on certain aspects. This Briefing Note is being issued to highlight those updates to OVs:

- the definition of a non-commercial move (page 1, point 2),
- how to complete the declaration (page 3, point 5,
- the time period required for vaccination (page 8, point 6 II.3)
- the time period required for signing of the AHC (page 2, point 4).
- new guidance for when owners are travelling with an assistance dog (page 5, point 5, final para).

#### **Action**

For those who have not yet done so, OVs are encouraged to access the NFG at their earliest opportunity to familiarise themselves with the updated guidance. OVs are reminded to regularly check NFGs and the latest guidance to ensure that they are not using out-of-date information
