Changes to iSam

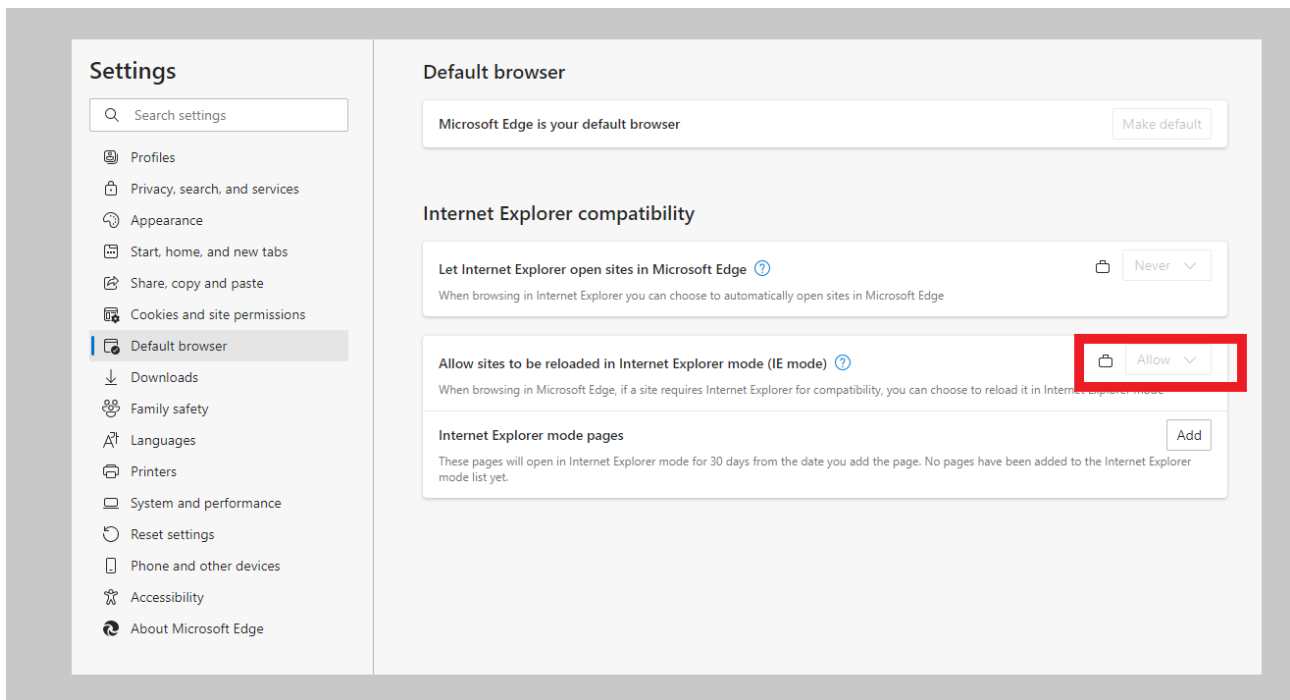

Purpose

1. To further inform Official Veterinarians (OVs) and all iSam users about the changes to iSam, which went live, today, 24 October 2022.
2. How to access the new iSam
3. How to update the capability mode users had previously been advised to set.
4. To inform users of planned Sam downtime in November 2022

Information

5. Please access iSam through the following page [Sam online TB test submission \(defra.gov.uk\)](https://defra.gov.uk/sam-online-tb-test-submission) clicking on the 'Log on' to Sam button. Please amend any shortcuts saved.
6. To amend the capability mode previously set please follow the steps below.
 - Settings
 - Default Browser
 - Allow sites to be reloaded in Internet Explore Mode (IE Mode) ensure this is set to **Don't Allow**.



7. You should now be able to access iSam through a greater range of internet browsers, see below, point 15
8. The upgrade will look significantly different but functionally will behave in the same way.
9. iSam will not be available at the following dates and times due to necessary downtime:
 - Tuesday 1 November 7pm until Wednesday 2 November 7am
 - Tuesday 8 November 7pm until Wednesday 9 November 7am
 - Tuesday 15 November 7pm until Wednesday 16 November 7am
10. Users should continue to contact the APHA IT Service Desk as they do now if they have any issues
11. We are aware of an issue viewing submitted work and sorting which we are currently investigating as a matter of urgency.

Action

12. Users should amend the settings of the capability mode as addressed above in step 6.
13. Please continue to contact the APHA IT Service Desk as normal if you have any issues.
14. Users should not attempt to log into iSam during the dates and times specified in paragraph 9 above.
15. Sam is now compatible with the following operating systems:
 - a) Microsoft Vista
 - b) Microsoft Windows 10
 - c) Microsoft Windows 8
 - d) Microsoft Windows 7
 - e) Mac OS X

Sam is now compatible with the following web browsers and software:

- b) Firefox

- d) Microsoft Edge Chromium
- e) Microsoft Office 2010
- f) Microsoft Office 2007
- g) Microsoft Office 2003
