6.	Bayliascariasis in ratites	Never recorded
7.	Borna disease in horses and ruminants	Last recorded 2008 in a horse imported from Germany
8.	Bovine anaplasmosis ( <i>Anaplasma marginale</i> and <i>A. centrale</i> )	Never recorded
9.	Bovine ephemeral fever	Never recorded
10.	Bovine venereal trichomoniasis ( <i>Trichomonas foetus</i> )	No reports this period. Last recorded date 1991
11.	<i>Brucella canis</i> infection	2017 - recorded in a dog imported from Serbia/Romania 2018 - recorded in a dog imported from Romania 2020 - recorded in multiple dogs at different locations, the origin of infection is thought to be dogs from Eastern Europe 2021 (update on 26/04/21) - recorded in multiple dogs at different locations within UK. Dogs are resident in UK but imported from overseas (primarily Eastern Europe) 2022 and 2023 ongoing cases (updated on 13/03/2023)

18.	Crimean Congo Haemorrhagic Fever (CCHF)	Human case confirmed in a traveller from Afghanistan Oct 2012 Second human case a traveller from Bulgaria July 2014
19.	Cysticercosis ( <i>Cysticercus cellulosae</i> )	Not recorded since 1992
20.	East Coast fever - Bovine Theileriosis ( <i>Theileria parva</i> )	Never recorded
21.	Equine encephalosis	Never recorded
22.	Equine paratyphoid ( <i>Salmonella abortus equi</i> )	Last reported in UK in 1989
23.	Equine piroplasmiasis	Last recorded in 2004 following transplacental transmission of <i>T. equi</i> (Phipps and Otter, Vet Record 2004, 154, 406-408) Autochthonous equine piroplasmiasis has never been recorded in GB
24.	European Brown Hare Syndrome	Prevalent in the UK wild hare population. Never recorded within wild European rabbit population or any farmed rabbits
25.	Getah virus infection	Never recorded
26.	Goose parvovirus	2008 - Irvine et al 2008 Vet Rec 164, 461
27.	Haemorrhagic septicaemia	Never recorded

28.	Hantavirus infection	Serological evidence in cats (1990) farmers (2000). 2012 - novel hantavirus in field vole - <i>Microtus agrestis</i> (EID 19: 673-5 2013) 2012 - Seoul virus in brown rat <i>Rattus norvegicus</i> (Eurosurveillance 2013; 18) 2012 - Seoul virus in brown rat - <i>Rattus norvegicus</i> (Health Protection Agency Report, Vol 7, 2013) 2013 - human case of renal failure - pet rats (Lancet 381 (9871): 170) 2014 - Gloucester and Doncaster human cases of SEOV HFRS 2014 - 32.9% SEOV seroprevalence in UK pet rat owners (PHE <a href="#">report</a> ) 2015 - Wales three linked cases of SEOV HFRS (Outbreak) - pet and feeder rats (unpublished) 2019 cases in wild rats

32.	Horse pox (Variola)	Not recorded since 1970 (anecdotal)

34.	Insects of the genera <i>Chrysomya</i> (Old world screw worm)	Never recorded
35.	Insects of the genera <i>Cochliomyia</i> (New world screw worm)	Never recorded
36.	Japanese <i>B. encephalitis</i> in horses	Never recorded

38.	Leishmania in dogs	Occasional cases in imported dogs. The sandfly vector is not present in the UK. No confirmed case in UK resident dogs
39.	Marburg disease	Never recorded
40.	Melioidosis	1990 - Group of imported monkeys Sporadic cases in man after arrival in GB from abroad
41.	Monkey pox	Increased human cases recorded since 2018 - all related to human transmission
42.	Nairobi sheep disease	Never recorded
43.	Nipah virus infection	Never recorded
44.	Potomac Horse Fever ( <i>Neorickettsia risticii</i> )	Never recorded
45.	Salmonella enterica subsp. enterica ser. Abortusovis in sheep	Last reported isolation 1984
46.	Seneca Valley Virus	Five cases in pigs in England between June and September 2022
47.	Stephanurosis (Pig kidney worm)	Never recorded
48.	Surra ( <i>Trypanosoma evansi</i> )	Never recorded in N. Ireland. For GB clearance see notifiable disease list ET171
49.	Trichinosis	Recorded in foxes 2009 in N. Ireland (never recorded in pigs). No positive test results recorded for GB herds since surveillance testing commenced in 1979
50.	Tsetse transmitted Trypanosomiasis	Never recorded
51.	Tularaemia ( <i>Francisella tularensis</i> )	Never recorded in animals or birds
52.	Vesicular exanthema	1974 in Pigs
53.	Wesselsbron disease	Never recorded
