6.	Bovine anaplasmosis (<i>Anaplasma marginale</i> and <i>A. centrale</i>)	Never Recorded
7.	Bovine ephemeral fever	Never Recorded
8.	Bovine venereal trichomoniasis (<i>Trichomonas foetus</i>)	Last recorded in GB 1991 Last recorded in Northern Ireland 1969
9.	<i>Brucella canis</i> infection	2017 - recorded in a dog imported from Serbia/ Romania 2018 - recorded in a dog imported from Romania 2020 - recorded in multiple dogs at different locations, the origin of infection is thought to be dogs from Eastern Europe. 2021 (update on 26 April 21) - recorded in multiple dogs at different locations within GB. Dogs are resident in GB but imported from overseas (primarily Eastern Europe)

11.	Camel Pox (Fever/Plague)	Never Recorded
12.	Canine Babesiosis in indigenous dogs: • <i>Babesia gibsoni</i> • <i>Babesia canis</i>	Recorded in 2015 in indigenous dogs in Harlow, Essex. Confirmed cases in Essex 2016 and 2017. (Never Recorded in Northern Ireland)
13.	Cervine paraelaphostrongylosis	Never Recorded
14.	Chuzan disease	Never Recorded
15.	Crimean Congo Haemorrhagic Fever (CCHF)	Human case confirmed in someone travelling to GB from Afghanistan in October 2012. Second human case in someone travelling to GB from Bulgaria in July 2014 (never recorded in Northern Ireland)
16.	Cysticercosis (<i>Cysticercus cellulosae</i>)	Last recorded in GB 1992 (never recorded in Northern Ireland)
17.	East Coast fever – Bovine Theileriosis (<i>Theileriaparva</i>)	Never Recorded
18.	Ebola virus	Recorded in GB 2014 and 2015 - human case in healthcare worker after returning from Sierra Leone (never recorded in Northern Ireland)
19.	Equine encephalosis	Never Recorded
20.	Equine paratyphoid (<i>Salmonella abortus equi</i>)	Last recorded in GB 1989 (never recorded in Northern Ireland)
21.	Equine piroplasmiasis	Last recorded in GB 2004 following transplacental transmission of <i>T. equi</i> (Phipps & Otter, <i>Vet Record</i> 2004, 154, 406-408) (never recorded in Northern Ireland) Autochthonous equine piroplasmiasis has never been recorded in GB
22.	European Brown Hare Syndrome	Prevalent in the UK wild hare population. Never recorded within wild European rabbit population or any farmed rabbits
23.	Getah virus infection	Never Recorded
24.	Goose parvovirus	Last recorded in GB 2008 - Irvine et al 2008 <i>Vet Rec</i> 164, 461 (never recorded in Northern Ireland)

25.	Hantavirus infection	1990 - serological evidence in cats in GB. 2000 - serological evidence among farmers in GB. 2003 - human laboratory-acquired infection in GB. 2012 - found in wild rodents in GB. 2012 - novel hantavirus in field vole - <i>Microtus agrestis</i> (EID 19:673-5 2013) in GB. 2012 - Seoul hantavirus in brown rat - <i>Rattus norvegicus</i> (Eurosurveillance 2013; 18) in GB. 2012 - Seoul hantavirus in brown rat - <i>Rattus norvegicus</i> (Health Protection Agency Report, Vol 7, 2013) in GB. 2013 - Seoul hantavirus in pet rats associated with human case of renal failure (Eurosurveillance 2013: 18-9; Lancet 381 (9871) 1070) in GB 2014 - Gloucester and Doncaster human cases of SEOV HFRS - pet rats (unpublished) 2014 - 32.0% SEOV seroprevalence in GB pet rat owners (PHE report) 2015 - human case in Wales in July 2015 (owner of a large colony of breeding rats). 2019 - cases in wild rats. (Never recorded in Northern Ireland)
26.	Heartwater (Cowdriosis) (<i>Ehrlichia/anaplasma ruminantium</i>)	Never Recorded
27.	Hendra virus infection	Never Recorded
28.	Horse pox (Variola)	Not Recorded in GB since 1970 (anecdotal) (never recorded in Northern Ireland)
29.	Ibaraki disease	Never Recorded
30.	Insects of the genera <i>Chrysomya</i> (Old world screw worm)	Never Recorded
31.	Insects of the genera <i>Cochliomyia</i> (New world screw worm)	Never Recorded
32.	Japanese <i>B. encephalitis</i> in horses	Never Recorded
33.	Leishmania in dogs	Occasional cases in imported dogs. The sandfly vector is not present in the UK. No confirmed case in UK resident dogs
34.	Marburg disease	Never Recorded
35.	Melioidosis	Recorded in GB1990 - in group of imported monkeys. Sporadic cases in man after arrival in GB from abroad (never recorded in Northern Ireland)
36.	Monkey pox	Four human cases recorded in GB in September 2018 and 2019, all were travellers from Central and West Africa. (Never recorded in Northern Ireland)
37.	Nairobi sheep disease	Never Recorded
38.	Nipah virus infection	Never Recorded
39.	Potomac Horse Fever (<i>Neorickettsia risticii</i>)	Never Recorded
40.	Stephanurosis (Pig kidney worm)	Never Recorded
41.	Surra (<i>Trypanosoma evansi</i>)	Never recorded in Equines. Last recorded in imported camelids in GB 1970-1979, exact date unknown (never recorded in Northern Ireland)
42.	Trichinosis	Recorded in foxes 2009 in Northern Ireland (never recorded in pigs). No positive test results recorded for GB herds since testing commenced in 1979
43.	Trichomoniasis	Present in birds in Northern Ireland (never recorded in GB)
44.	Tsetse transmitted Trypanosomiasis	Never Recorded
45.	Tularaemia (<i>Francisella tularensis</i>)	Never recorded in animals or birds
46.	Vesicular exanthema	Last recorded in GB 1974 in pigs (never recorded in Northern Ireland)
47.	Wesselsbron disease	Never Recorded
