## Notice Requiring Detention and Isolation of Affected or Suspected Animals and Prohibiting Movement of Deer and their Carcasses

To:

CPHH No.

I, the undersigned, being a Veterinary Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State/Scottish Ministers, hereby give you notice in accordance with the provisions of the above Order that, as the keeper of the deer specified below which is an affected or suspected animal for the purposes of the above Order, you are required:

\*(a) to detain the said deer:

see Appendix 1 for deer identification/\*insert description of deer

and to keep them isolated, as far as practicable, from other deer and from cattle on the following premises:

\*(b) to ensure that no deer or carcasses are moved on to or off the following premises except under the authority of a licence issued by a Veterinary Inspector and in accordance with any conditions subject to which the licence is issued:

This notice remains in force until it is withdrawn by a further notice served by a Veterinary Inspector.

Breach of the requirements of this notice may constitute an offence against the Animal Health Act 1981 and render a person liable to penalties on conviction.
